Tomás Taborda is a Portuguese actor who has been establishing himself as one of the most promising names of his generation, with a career that combines acting, music, and theatre. He attended the theatre course at the Escola Superior de Teatro e Cinema in Lisbon, and also has a background in music, having studied viola at the Conservatório de Música de Coimbra. In theatre, he made his stage debut in 2021 with the international show 'Trouble', under the direction of the prestigious American director Gus Van Sant. More recently, he joined the cast of the play 'Telhados de Vidro', directed by Marco Medeiros, which ran at the Teatro da Trindade.

On television, he made his debut in the fiction series 'Vanda' and, shortly after, joined the cast of 'Rua das Flores'. He gained widespread recognition among the audience by portraying the charismatic Harry in the return of the iconic series 'Morangos com Açúcar', a co-production distributed internationally by Amazon Prime. This was followed by appearances in the series 'Erro 404', 'Lugar 54', and 'Terra Forte'. Recently, he joined the cast of the anthology series 'Psicopatas', created by Justin Amorim.

In cinema, his career includes a role in the feature film 'Portugueses', directed by Vicente Alves do Ó.
