Inês Herédia is a Portuguese actress with a versatile career spanning theatre, television and film, both in Portugal and internationally.

She trained at the Escola Superior de Teatro e Cinema in Lisbon before moving to London, where she completed a Master's in Acting for Screen at the Royal Central School of Speech & Drama with distinction, and studied at the Musical Theatre Academy. On stage, she has performed in productions such as the musical 'Chicago', playing Roxie Hart at Teatro da Trindade, and 'Things I Know to Be True' with the Lisbon Players.

On television, she has appeared in acclaimed series such as 'Paixão' (SIC), 'Quer o Destino', 'Festa é Festa', 'A Protegida', 'A Madrasta' (TVI) and 'Marquesa de Alorna' (RTP).

Internationally, she featured in the German Netflix series 'Charité IV', the American CBS series 'FBI: International', and in a film by British director Nish Gera, in which she plays the lead.

The documentary 'O Visconde Indomável', in which she serves as the narrative thread, won the Gold Award in the Documentary/History category at the World Media Festival 2025 in Berlin.
